Notable Species observed during the period:

Western Grebe - An outstanding spring sighting for the Pineywoods was a Western Grebe at Lake Bob Sandlin, *Titus* 1 Mar (ph. David Brotherton).

Virginia Rail - Three Virginia Rails 5 miles west of Houston County Lake, *Houston* 15 May (Barrett Riess) were unusual and late migrants through east Texas.

Lesser Black-backed Gull- A Lesser Black-backed Gull on the uppermost portion of Lake Livingston, *Trinity* 29 Mar (Tony Frank, Mike Austin) was a nice find.

Common Loon - Toledo Bend Reservoir, *Sabine* held an impressive count of 65 Common Loons as late as 8 Apr (David Bell).

Brown Pelican - A Brown Pelican was a nice find on Lake Palestine, *Smith* 22 Mar (Sonny Bratz).
