## <u>Pineywoods/East Texas – Winter 2019-2020 (1 Dec 2019 – 29 Feb 2020)</u> <u>Noteworthy Bird Sightings</u>

<u>Counties Covered</u>: Anderson, Angelina, Bowie, Camp, Cass, Cherokee, Franklin, Gregg, Hardin, Harrison, Henderson, Houston, Jasper, Marion, Morris, Nacogdoches, Newton, Panola, Polk, Red River, Rusk, Sabine, San Augustine, San Jacinto, Shelby, Smith, Titus, Trinity, Tyler, Upshur, Walker

Notable Species observed during the period:

**Solitary Sandpiper** - A Solitary Sandpiper northeast of Huntsville, *Walker* 29 Dec (ph. Erik Wolf) was a nice find for the Pineywoods so late in the season.

**Little Gull** - Outstanding finds were single Little Gulls at Lake Cypress Springs, *Franklin* 8-11 Dec (Steve Glover, Greg Cook) and on Lake Bob Sandlin, *Camp* 21 Feb (Greg Cook, Blaine Carnes).

**Lesser Black-backed Gull** - Though the species is now quite common along the coast, as many as 6 Lesser Black-backed Gulls were near the dam on Lake Livingston, *San Jacinto* 6-20 Dec (Fred Collins, Ted Drozdowski) was one of the higher inland counts for this species in Texas.

**Zone-tailed Hawk** - An irregular visitor to the Pineywoods, a Zone-tailed Hawk was unexpected at Huntsville S.P. south of Huntsville, *Walker* 4 Jan (Darrell Vollert).

**Crested Caracara** - A Crested Caracara just south of De Kalb, *Bowie* 24-25 Dec (Judy Reeves) was at the far northeast edge of where the species can be found.

**Ash-throated Flycatcher** - Ash-throated Flycatchers are seldom detected in the Pineywoods so one near Toledo Bend Reservoir east of Milam, *Sabine* 4 Jan (David Bell) was a highlight of the season.

**Great Kiskadee** - A pair of Great Kiskadees below the Lake Livingston Dam spillway, *Polk* 25 Feb (ph. Cinda Crosley, Jean Martin) was certainly the same birds detected there in mid-November.

**Bullock's Oriole** - A Bullock's Oriole 15 miles northeast of Crockett, *Houston* 11-15 Feb (ph. Barrett Riess) was out of place and perhaps a bird that over-wintered in the area.

**Palm Warbler** - An irregular wintering bird away from the coast, a Palm Warbler south of Massey Lake, *Anderson* 4 Jan (ph. Bonnie McKenzie, Laura Wilson) was a bit surprising.

**Yellow-throated Warbler** - A Yellow-throated Warbler east of Lakeport, *Harrison* 30 Jan - 3 Feb (David Brotherton) was certainly one of the northernmost wintering sightings of this species in the state ever.

**Summer Tanager** - A Summer Tanager lingered much of the season in Lufkin, *Angelina* until 5 Jan (ph. Gary Hunter).
